Committee Members expressed concern regarding the works still outstanding given the project end date is 31 January 2025. The clerk was instructed to arrange a further onsite meeting with Chris Hunter as early as possible next week.

Cllr Berryman advised that Fowey Town Council had very kindly agreed to give to the Council two black and gold planters they no longer use. It was

decided that these two four foot planters should be positioned outside the Guildhall.

Mayor Henderson advised that she had met representatives of Duchy Nurseries in Taprell courtyard. They had advised on plant species for the area based on it's limited light and the various positions of the planters. It was **resolved** to order another bag of chippings and a further 15 bags of compost from Walter Bailey, 2 x picnic benches from Duchy Timber (maximum budget £500) and plants from Duchy Nurseries to the value of £500.-
